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SUMMARY

I build web products end to end, from the database and API to the interface people actually use. My core stack is TypeScript with React and Tailwind, and I've also built full-stack projects with Node.js, Supabase, Django and Python.

Four years in, I've grown from UX design into full-time development, moving from intern to mid-level and shipping real products in professional teams. My strongest work is on the front end, where a UX background (Google Certified) means I make interface decisions rather than just implementing them, but I'm comfortable owning a feature from the data layer up.

What I bring:

- Full-stack development across TypeScript, Next.js, Node.js, Supabase and Django, with React, Tailwind, JavaScript, HTML and CSS
- Front-end depth backed by real UX training, not just a framework checklist
- Products shipped in professional teams, remote and hybrid

Consequently, I help create products that are intuitive, consistent, and easy to maintain, overseeing the entire process from problem analysis to production deployment.

On the back end, I used Python and Django to create and maintain models, views, migrations, and Django Admin configurations, contributing to data structure and business logic. I also worked on troubleshooting, project maintenance, and feature enhancements, supporting tasks from requirements analysis through delivery. During this period, I progressed from Front-End Developer Intern to Front-End Developer II, taking on greater autonomy and technical responsibility.

Front-End Developer (Intern) — Novadata

As a Front-End Developer Intern, I supported the development and maintenance of digital products for clients across different industries. I worked primarily with JavaScript, React, Astro, HTML, CSS, WordPress, and Webflow, building responsive interfaces, fixing layout and usability issues, and assisting with the implementation of new features. I also gained experience with Python and Django through contributions involving models, views, migrations, and Django Admin configurations. Throughout the internship, I strengthened my technical foundation, learned to work within professional development workflows, and gradually took on more complex tasks and greater responsibility, which led to my promotion to Front-End Developer II.

At AltoTech, I developed responsive websites using JavaScript, Bootstrap, and Tailwind CSS.
